- 6:00pm: Welcome Drinks in the Lobby
 - Try a glass of wine or beer while we meet each other for this whirlwind weekend
- 7:30pm: 4 course Dinner at Emeril's NOLA Louisiana Blue Crab Cake with Corn Coulis to Buttermilk Fried Breast of Chicken with Bourbon Mashed Sweet Potatoes, Country Ham Cream Gravy and Sautéed Sugar Snap Peas to Famous Emeril's Bread Pudding.
- 10:00pm: Evening on your own to enjoy Jazz in the Quarter

Saturday April 14th, 2012

Hotel 3 star French Quarter Area Hotel

- 8:30am: Breakfast at the World Famous Café du Monde Enjoying a plate of Biegnets to Café Au Lait. Then look though the windows to see them in production.
- 10:00am: 4-course Cooking Class and Lunch in New Orleans Cuisine Gumbo, Red Beans and Rice, Jambalaya, and Buttery Pralines
- 2:00pm: City Tour aboard our deluxe motor coach. We will tour: the historical, cemeteries, Garden District and the city of New Orleans before heading out of town to Nottaway Planation. Built in 1859 for

the Randolph family with 11 children. After our private tour we will feast at the Mansion Restaurant for our 3-course dinner.

8:00pm: We will return back to our hotel so you can enjoy the evening.

8:00am: Historical 4-course Brunch at Brennan's. Home of the Bananas Foster. Awarded a James Beard Award and the Food Network Best Dessert awards.

Continuing to Tour B:

Hotel: 3 star French Quarter Area Hotel

- 1:30pm: Historical Food Tasting and Walking Tour of New Orleans We will walk (bring the tennis shoes) throughout the quarter. We tour select historic restaurants and discuss their culinary contributions - including the two oldest (Antoine's and Tujague's, established in 1840 and 1856, respectively). You will learn to appreciate the differences between Creole and Cajun cuisine, and will hear of the varied ethnic influences that contribute to New Orleans cuisine. The samples may include: Seafood Gumbo, Red Beans & Rice, Beef Brisket with Creole Sauce, Pralines, Muffulettas, Gelato, Turtle Soup and Shrimp Remoulade.
- 5:30pm: Motor Coach tour of the 9th Ward that was devastated in 2005 during Hurricane Katrina and then a tour of the Mansions of the Garden District along the route of the St. Charles Street Cars.
 8:00pm Ralph Brennan's Red Fish Grill. A 3-course menu of mouthwatering proportions!
